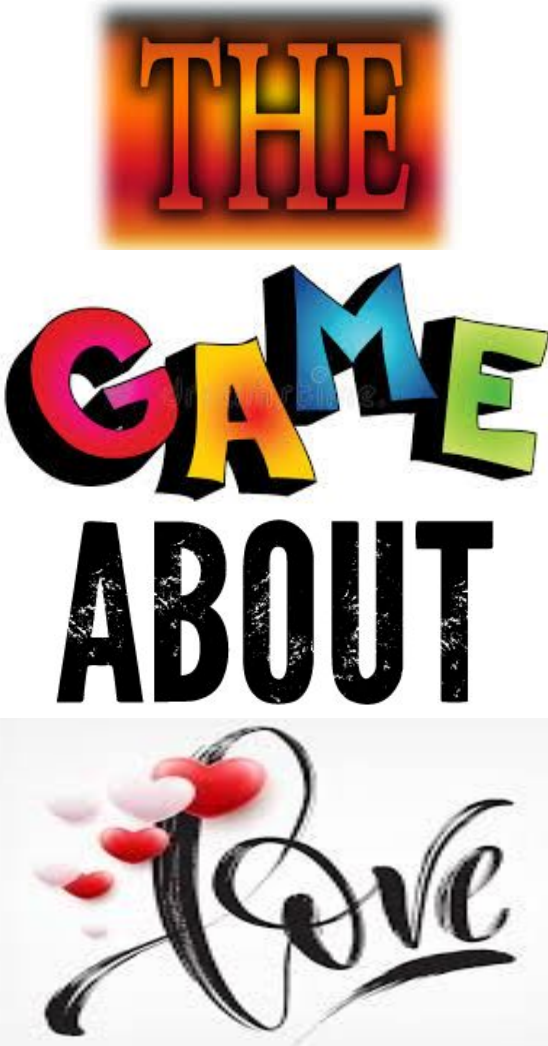

RULES OF THE GAME

You will need one dice, pawns and the cards that come with the game.

1. Start at a head and the youngest player starts by throwing the dice and picking up a card that links to what they land on.
2. If you answer the card you land on incorrectly/or can't answer you lose a turn next round. Follow the instructions on the card if they tell you to move back or forward or miss a turn.
3. The winner is the player that gets to the end first.
